Alison's play A Street Like This produced by Unfolding Theatre premiered at The Fire Station in June 2023 and it was subsequently named 'Performance of the Year' at the North East Culture Awards 2023.

Alison's play *Birdie* was a Finalist for The Women's Prize for Playwriting 2022. The judging panel's commentary included "an outstanding, highly accomplished play which evinces your terrific skill and power as a theatre writer ... a play with a richly uncomfortable, disturbing atmosphere, posing deeply troubling moral questions with a light touch and enormous deftness".
